Spring Camporee

April 21-23, 2017 - This year's camporee will be held at McNaughton Field 8675 Paxton Street in Hummelstown (Swatara township near the Sewage Treatment Facility). The theme is Outdoor Ethics. Hickory Run Campout

May 5-7, 2017 - We will complete the Wilderness Survival and Orienteering merit badges. Cost for this event is \$15. More information coming as we get closer to the event.

Shrewsberry Merit Badge Camporee

Summer Camp

June 25 - July 1, 2017 is the week the troop will be attending summer camp. We are going to Camp Ockanickon (about 90 minutes east of here). I've received a lot of

information from Camp Ockanickon as we prepare.

First, ALL scouts and leaders are required to have an updated Annual Health Record to bring to camp. Parts A, B, and C must be completed. An annual health and medical record is **valid through the end of the 12th month from the date it was administered by your medical provider**. For example, a physical administered March 3, 2016, would be valid until March 31, 2017. All medical forms must be valid through the camp week. If a form expires halfway through our week at camp, you must get an updated physical prior to our arrival. The troop will also need a copy of the Health Record for our medical kit. A blank form was included in a recent Summer Camp e-mail.

For our troop, new scouts are typically signed up for the Dan Beard program. This is a program designed for new scouts to complete numerous requirements for Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, and First Class ranks. Scouts in the program will earn their Swimming and Art merit badges as well.

A listing of merit badges that are offered at camp (and when they are offered), along with any prerequisites, has been distributed via e-mail. When deciding on which badges to work on, scouts should be careful to try and prevent running back and forth across the entire camp to go from one badge to the next. Not always possible, but a helpful tip. Scouts in the Dan Beard program will NOT have time to earn additional badges.

A scout should sign up for no more than 3-4 merit badges for the week. There are a couple reasons for this. One, it allows for more 'free' time to do other activities like open shooting, open boating, open swimming, climbing, volleyball tournament, etc. Two, time. Too much work for the week may result in partial merit badge completions, which will require additional work of the scout away from camp, and would involve finding a new counselor to finish the badge. We'd like to see the boys complete their badges at camp. Something to keep in mind.
