# Upcoming Adventure

#### **Summer Camp**

June 25 - July 1, 2017 is the week the troop will be attending summer camp. We are going to Camp Ockanickon (about 90 minutes east of here).

ALL scouts and leaders are required to have an updated Annual Health Record to bring to camp. Parts A, B, and C must be completed. An annual health and medical record is **valid through the end of the 12th month from the date it was administered by your medical provider**. For example, a physical administered March 3, 2016, would be valid until March 31, 2017. All medical forms must be valid through the camp week. If a form expires halfway through our week at camp, you must get an updated physical prior to our arrival. The troop will also need a copy of the Health Record for our medical kit. A blank form was included in a recent Summer Camp e-mail.

A listing of merit badges that are offered at camp (and when they are offered), along with any prerequisites, has been distributed via e-mail. It will be sent out one more time before we leave for camp. By now, scouts have chosen what merit badges they want to work on and should finish all prerequisite work prior to arrival at camp. Scouts in the Dan Beard program will be working on the Swimming and Art merit badges as well as requirements for Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First class. All scouts will have opportunities to work on merit badges in the evenings as well, if they choose to do so.

If you ordered t-shirts for summer camp, the cost is \$14.95 per shirt and is due to Mr. Mosier as soon as possible. If there are any questions regarding camp, merit badges, etc, please feel free to contact Mr. Schaffer.
